Hunts Point Anarchists: An eyewitness account...

There was a mass meeting at the Hunts Point palace where Emma Goldman and either Eastman or Tresky spoke. After the meeting the participants marched up Southern Boulevard to Westchester Avenue. I stood on the corner of Westchester Avenue and 130th Boulevard and as they came up they were screaming and chanting, when they neared Westchester Avenue they gave out a most terrifying loud moan as they met the police.



As you know Emma Goldman was one of the leading radicals of the time. I do not think we called them Communists, I don't think that term was used then.
