

CEMETERY CLEAN-UP DUE

Joseph Rodman Drake Park Will Be Restored

The Department of Parks is moving to restore the cemetery where the poet Joseph Rodman Drake lies buried in the Hunts Point section of the Bronx.

John A. Mulcahy, executive officer of the department, said yesterday that most of the Joseph Rodman Drake park clean-up would be done in ten days. Where the monuments have been badly vandalized, the restoration may take two months, he said. Rehabilitation of the hedges, he said, must wait until fall.
